SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- A \$15.00 EMT and \$20.00 Office Fee will be charged to all entries at each show. Class Fees are indicated with class descriptions.
- Jackpot classes will have a 40% payout of the class entry total money.

Money will be paid as follows: 1st - 12%, 2nd - 10%, 3rd - 7%, 4th –5%, 5th – 4%, 6th – 2%

- Prize money will be applied to show account. If additional prize money needs to be issued, it will be mailed within 30 days. Prize Money recipient MUST provide a completed W-9 to show management prior to receiving a prize money check.
- Any open invoices will be closed by office staff at the end of the show with the method of payment holding the entry. It is the exhibitors responsibility to review their bill and resolve any discrepancies within one hour of the show ending. If disputes are not negotiated within this time frame the bill stands without further review. A charge of \$40 will be imposed on all returned checks. Any and all costs incurred to collect unpaid funds are the responsibility of the obligated party.
- No exhibitor numbers will be issued without payment being secured. Open signed check or credit card number are acceptable and must be provided with the completed entry form and proof of current health papers in order to receive the exhibitor number.
- Venmo, Paypal, cash, Google/Apple Pay, Card or Check may be used as a form of entry payment
- All riders must wear proper attire and certified protective headgear at all times while mounted.
- All shows are presented by Blue Crab Horse Shows and Bay View Farm LLC and its employees, representatives, host property owners/leasers, Alison Fisher, or any member of the show management will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, theft or damage at the show. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor to hold the same blameless or harmless for any accident or loss.
- Schooling will be permitted only in areas provided by the show management.
- Back numbers issued must be worn while in the show ring for scoring to count.
- All pets must be kept on a leash at all times accompanied with a person or tied to heavy item (truck, trailer, etc)
- The show management further has the authority to remove anyone or any horse from the show grounds.
- Sharps containers will be located at the secretary stand.
- Every class offered will practice the rules and specifications determined by the current USEF Rulebook as applicable and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- Access to the private barn and any additional private buildings will be off limits unless otherwise stated.
- Excessive use of whips, spurs or other methods determined by the Judge or Show Management will not be tolerated of any kind.
- Any fall of Horse/Rider will automatically disqualify the rider from the class in which the rider/horse fell (only exception while in the jumper ring, if the fall of a Horse/Rider occurs before the start timers are triggered and after the finish timers are triggered.)
- A show manager visit may be requested if any harmful or reckless riding, neglectful horse care or instruction is observed while on the show grounds.
- Show Management limits the number of classes to (6) that a horse may compete within the same day regardless of the number of riders. The welfare of all the Horses/Ponies is our priority.
- **All schooling series pre-entries will be due by 5pm the Wednesday of the horse show.** Any entries received later than the 5pm Wednesday will receive a \$25 late fee. All entries are encouraged to be submitted for no additional cost at Horseshowing.com

Basic Jumper Class Rules:

- ❖ Rider must jump the jumps in the numbered order on the course map. The red flag on the top of the standard is to remain on the riders right hand side to dictate jump direction. Any jump being jumped both directions will have red flags on both the left and right hand standards. The judge will sound the tone to notify the rider they can begin, each rider will have 45 seconds from the sound of the tone to start their round. If failed to do so, the judge will start the time.
- ❖ Training tools such as Draw Reins, German Martingales, Standing/Running Martingales are permitted to be used in Jumper classes.
- ❖ Training tools such as Gouge's, Neck Stretchers, etc are not permitted to be used in any class.
- ❖ (3) refusals in each round will be permitted. Once the (3) refusals has occurred the rider will be eliminated from the round and asked leave the ring.
- ❖ Neutral colored Breeches with a Show Shirt or Polo are permitted. Jackets are not required. Shirts are to be tucked in.
- ❖ Tall Boots, Paddock Boots w/ Jodphur Straps or Paddock Boots w/half chaps (Brown or Black) are permitted.
- ❖ Entry numbers are to be worn on the riders back or pinned to the saddle pad. If pinned on the saddle pad, please be sure to put it on the side of the in-gate starter for easy visibility.
- ❖ Buzzer tone meanings:
 - (1) Buzzer tone: The horse has refused and knocked over the jump the judge will sound the tone to notify the rider to hold while the crew repairs the jump. The timer will be paused, once ready the judge will sound the tone to notify the rider to resume the course starting at the point of refusal.
 - (2) Buzzer tone: The rider incurred 3 refusals or went off course. The judge is notify the rider that they have been eliminated from the round and are being asked to leave the ring.
- ❖ Braided pony tails/hairnets will be acceptable for riders under their helmet

Basic Hunter/Equitation Class Rules:

- ❖ Standing Martingales are permitted to be used in all over fences classes.
- ❖ Standing Martingales are **NOT** permitted to be used in Lead Line, Short/Long Stirrup or any under saddle classes
- ❖ Training tools such as Draw Reins, Gouge's, Neck Stretchers, German Martingales, etc are not permitted to be used in any hunter class.
- ❖ Saddle Shaped Saddle pads (i.e. fitted pads) are to be used in all hunter classes. Square saddle pads are not permitted.
- ❖ Back Numbers are to be worn on the riders back during the class
- ❖ Neutral colored Breeches with a Show Shirt or Polo are permitted. Jackets are not required. Shirts are to be tucked in.
- ❖ Tall Boots, Jodphur Straps w/ Paddock Boots or Paddock Boots w/ half chaps (Brown or Black) are permitted.
- ❖ Simple changes of lead during over fences classes will not be penalized. Rider's execution of the lead change will be taken into account.
- ❖ Braided pony tails/hairnets will be acceptable for riders under their helmet
- ❖ Adults are permitted to ride ponies. Suitability will be taken into account.
